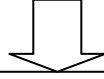


National Black Boys Can Association

Process For Becoming A New Franchisee

Enquiry Stage

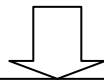
An initial enquiry is made by an interested individual or organisation. An application form will be sent out.



Initial Assessment

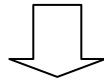
The National Black Boys Can Association will consider the completed application and make an initial decision about the suitability of the organisation to become a franchisee.

Application form will be sent out to the individual/group.



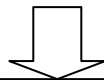
Management Team

Organisations who are encouraged to proceed at this stage will be required to recruit a team of volunteers who are interested in setting up a Black Boys Can Project.



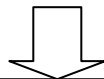
Presentation

The National Black Boys Can Association will arrange to meet with the team and deliver a presentation outlining the contents of the franchise agreement and the commitment required to run the project.



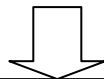
The Board considers application

The Board of Directors will give due consideration to the application and make an informed decision as to whether it is appropriate to offer the Franchisee to the applicant



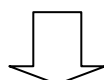
Franchise agreement signed

Applicants who are approved by the Board at the above stage will be invited to sign the Franchise agreement.



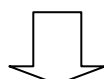
Induction Training

All new Franchisees will be inducted into the organisation and the programmes. New Franchisees will be notified of the next scheduled induction-training day.



Submission of Outline Plan

The new franchise will then be expected to draw up a plan of action using a proforma provided.



Allocation of a Franchisee Support Manager

A Franchise Support Manager will be allocated to all new Franchisees.
